 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Smithsonian National
 - 5 Museum of the American Latino Act".
 - 6 SEC. 2. SITE OF SMITHSONIAN NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE
 - 7 AMERICAN LATINO.
 - 8 (a) Authorizing Site Within Reserve of Na-
 - 9 TIONAL MALL.—

1	(1) In General.—Notwithstanding any other
2	provision of law or regulation, including section
3	8908(c) of title 40, United States Code, the Smith-
4	sonian National Museum of the American Latino
5	may be located within the Reserve (as defined in sec-
6	tion 8902(a) of title 40, United States Code).
7	(2) Conforming Amendment.—Section
8	201(g)(4) of division T of the Consolidated Appro-
9	priations Act, 2021 (20 U.S.C. $80u(g)(4)$) is amend-
10	ed by striking ", except that" and all that follows
11	and inserting a period.
12	(b) Use of Site Under the Jurisdiction of An-
13	OTHER FEDERAL AGENCY.—Section 201(g)(2) of division
14	T of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021 (20
15	U.S.C. $80u(g)(2)$) is amended to read as follows:
16	"(2) Site under the jurisdiction of an-
17	OTHER FEDERAL AGENCY.—
18	"(A) Notification to other agency or
19	ENTITY.—The Board of Regents shall not des-
20	ignate a site for the Museum that is under the
21	administrative jurisdiction of another Federal
22	agency or entity without first notifying the head
23	of the Federal agency or entity.
24	"(B) Notification to committees.—
25	Once notified under subparagraph (A), the head

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of the Federal agency or entity shall promptly submit written notification to the Chair and ranking minority members of the Committee on Rules and Administration, the Committee on Appropriations, and the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources of the Senate, and the Committee on House Administration, the Committee on Natural Resources, the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and the Committee on Appropriations of the House of Representatives, stating that the Federal agency or entity was notified by the Board of Regents that a site under its jurisdiction was designated and that a transfer will be initiated as soon as practicable.

"(C) Transfer.—As soon as practicable after the date on which the individuals described in subparagraph (B) receive the written notification described in such subparagraph, the head of the Federal agency or entity shall transfer to the Smithsonian Institution its administrative jurisdiction over the land or structure that has been designated as the site for the Museum."

2	POINTS AND AUTHENTIC EXPERIENCES.—Section
3	201(d)(2)(D) of division T of the Consolidated Appropria-
4	tions Act, 2021 (20 U.S.C. 80u(d)(2)(D)) is amended to

6	"(D) Ensuring diversity of political
7	VIEWPOINTS AND AUTHENTIC EXPERIENCES.—
8	"(i) In General.—The Board of
9	Trustees shall ensure that the exhibits and
10	programs of the Museum accurately and
11	comprehensively represent the varied cul-
12	tures, histories, events, and values of His-
13	panic or Latino communities.
14	"(ii) Specific requirements.—In
15	carrying out its duties, the Board of Trust-
16	ees shall ensure that it seeks and utilizes
17	to its maximum ability guidance from a
18	broad array of knowledgeable and re-
19	spected sources reflecting the diversity of
20	the political viewpoints and authentic expe-
21	riences held by Hispanics or Latinos in the
22	United States, and shall seek such guid-
23	ance for both the creation and substantial
24	revision of exhibits and programs.

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1	"(iii) Definitions.—In this subpara-
2	graph—
3	"(I) the term 'broad array
4	means a range of experts and publica-
5	tions that represent the broad spec-
6	trum of Hispanic or Latino commu-
7	nities, to include varied viewpoints
8	political ideologies, cultures, and lived
9	experiences in the United States; and
10	"(II) the term 'knowledgeable
11	and respected source' means an indi-
12	vidual who has gained through edu-
13	cation, publication, or witnessing ar
14	important or historical event, the abil-
15	ity to advise on at least one unique
16	viewpoint or experience of a particular
17	Hispanic or Latino community, and
18	whose knowledge has been relied upon
19	by a notable segment of that commu-
20	nity for education, heritage preserva-
21	tion, or historical purposes, and in-
22	cludes the work of such an individual
23	which reflects such ability and knowl-
24	edge.".

1 (d) Reports to Congress.—Not later than 120 2 days after the date of enactment of this Act and every 3 2 years thereafter, the Secretary of the Smithsonian shall 4 submit to the Committee on Natural Resources of the 5 House of Representatives, the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources of the Senate, the Committee on House 6 Administration of the House of Representatives, the Com-7 8 mittee on Rules and Administration of the Senate, the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the 10 House of Representatives, the Committee on Appropriations of the House of Representatives, and the Committee 11 12 on Appropriations of the Senate, a report on actions taken by the Director of the Smithsonian National Museum of the American Latino Museum and the Board of Trustees 14 15 of the Museum to comply with the requirements of the amendments made by subsection (c), including a descrip-16 17 tion of actions taken with respect to substantial revisions

- 18 of current exhibits and programs as well the planning of
- 19 future exhibits and programs.
- 20 (e) Effective Date.—This section and the amend-
- 21 ments made by this section shall take effect as if included
- 22 in the enactment of section 201 of division T of the Con-
- 23 solidated Appropriations Act, 2021 (20 U.S.C. 80u).
