3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "University Centers for
- 5 Growth, Development, and Prosperity Act of 2022".

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1SEC. 2. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AGENCY UNIVERSITY2CENTERS.

3 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—Title II of the Public Works
4 and Economic Development Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C. 3141
5 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end the following:
6 "SEC. 219. UNIVERSITY CENTERS.

7 "(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall make
8 awards to institutions of higher learning for such institu9 tions to serve as university centers.

10 "(b) GEOGRAPHIC COVERAGE.—The Secretary shall
11 ensure that one university center is established in each
12 State to provide services in such State.

13 "(c) PRIORITIZATION OF HISTORICALLY BLACK COL-LEGES AND UNIVERSITIES, TRIBAL COLLEGES AND UNI-14 VERSITIES, HISPANIC-SERVING INSTITUTIONS, AND MI-15 16 NORITY-SERVING INSTITUTIONS.—In establishing univer-17 sity centers under this section, the Secretary shall 18 prioritize institutions of higher education that are eligible to receive funds under section 371(a) of the Higher Edu-19 cation Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1067q(a)). 20

21 "(d) DUTIES.—The university centers established
22 under this section, to the extent practicable, shall—

23 "(1) collaborate with other university centers;
24 "(2) collaborate with economic development dis25 tricts, trade adjustment assistance centers, Hollings
26 Manufacturing Extension Partnership Centers of the

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National Institute of Standards and Technology,
Business Centers and Rural Business Centers of the
Minority Business Development Agency, and other
relevant Federal economic development technical as-
sistance and service providers to provide expertise,
applied research, and technical assistance to develop,
implement, and support regional strategies that as-
sist in job creation, high-skilled regional talent pools,
and business expansion in a region's innovation clus-
ter;
"(3) provide technical assistance, business de-
velopment services, and technology transfer services
to businesses in the service area of the university
center;
"(4) establish partnerships with one or more
commercialization intermediaries that are public or
nonprofit technology transfer organizations eligible
to receive a grant under section $602(d)(1)(B)$ of the
American Innovation and Competitiveness Act $(42$
U.S.C. 1862s–9(d)(1)(B)); and
"(5) provide to communities and regions assist-
ance relating to data collection and analysis and
other research relating to economic conditions and
vulnerabilities that can inform economic development
and adjustment strategies.

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"(e) FUNDING.—The Secretary may provide to each
 university center under this section for each fiscal year
 an amount that is not less than \$500,000 and not more
 than \$1,000,000.".

5 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 3(12) of
6 the Public Works and Economic Development Act of 1965
7 (42 U.S.C. 3122(12)) is amended by inserting "a univer8 sity center established under section 219 or" after
9 "means".

10 (c) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents 11 in section 1(b) of the Public Works and Economic Devel-12 opment Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C. 3121 note) is amended 13 by inserting after the item relating to section 218 the fol-14 lowing new item:

"Sec. 219. University centers.".
