2 scribed in subsection (a).

3       (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no  
4 funds provided under this Act or any other Act shall be  
5 disbursed from the United States Treasury to refund any  
6 court-ordered compensation, including restitution, fines,  
7 or special assessments, paid by any individual convicted  
8 for involvement in the attack on the United States Capitol  
9 on January 6, 2021, including any individual so convicted  
10 and subsequently pardoned.

11       (d) The Secretary of the Treasury shall transfer any  
12 amounts described in subsection (c) to the account appro-  
13 priated under the heading “Architect of the Capitol—Cap-  
14 itol Building” for the maintenance, care, and operation  
15 of the United States Capitol and amounts transferred  
16 under this subsection shall remain available until expended
